
How does Auto-fill work?


-Print the pages you want and then type different words in the purple boxes on the first page to create DIFFERENT pages. The purple boxes will NOT show when printing, you will only see the word.

Students use a dice to roll and read words. Each word they read, they will color a certain color! Students are done when they have colored the words in 3 FULL columns.

Students will color each sight word according to the color code at the top. Next, they will graph how many of each word they found. BONUS: YOU get to decide the colors in the color code too!








Students will write each sight word in Halloween pictures using the code on the right. BONUS:


Ask students to create their own sentence using the Halloween picture code in the bottom box.

Students will sort each word based on whether it is spelled CORRECTLY (a TREAT) or spelled INCORRECTLY (a TRICK). *The 4 words spelled CORRECTLY are listed in the boxes at the top.





Students will sort each word and paste it on top of the matching Trick-or-Treat bag.




Give students a pencil and paperclip to create a spinner. Students will spin a word and write it in a box. They will continue spinning and writing words until all boxes are filled.


BONUS: Ask students to color the vowel(s) in each word using the color code blow.





Tape the cards in different places around the classroom. Ask students to walk around the find each word cards. Using the 15 task cards, students will write each word in the matching numbered box.





PRINTABLE GAME. Give each player a small coin or a colored counter and a dice. Students will use the word cards to practice reading. If they flip over a picture card, they move to that image (just like the game CANDYLAND). After reading, students will roll a dice to find out how many spots they can move.
