
BONUS: Students can count the number of letters in each word and trace each word in a certain color based on the number of letters using the color code at the bottom of the page.








- I. Students will roll a dice to get a word.

TIPS:


- -Ask students to organize all 4 sentences BEFORE pasting.

Students will use the code to write each word in code picture form and write the number of vowels in the word. Next, students will create their own sentence using this code.







Students will need <u>a partner</u>, a dice, and two different colored crayons. Each player will choose one of the colored crayons and write their name in that color at the bottom of the page. Each players rolls and the highest number goes first. Students will take turns rolling the dice and coloring the word associated with that number. Players will try to color 4 sight words to make a row (up, down, or diagonal) to win. If students roll a word that is already <u>all</u> colored, roll again.

Roll, Move, And Color


Students roll the dice. 2. Each time students roll the dice, they will read the words and act out the action in that row. 3. Students will color a circle at the bottom of the page to keep track of how many rows they have read.

 ---Students will roll a total of 10 times and color a circle at the bottom of the page for each row they read.
 Using the color code, students will color each word accordingly.







Sight word spirals



Students will use a different color for each word to FILL IN EACH SPIRAL (with the sight word shown) as many times as they can.




Sight word shopping



Students will use the amounts listed below to add up the amount of each letter in each word and show the addition equation they used to find the total amount in the rectangle. Students will write the total amount of the word on the tag.



FIND, PASHE, AND DRAW



Students will write in the missing sight word in the blank space and then paste it in the rectangle on the right.

Next, students will draw a picture of the meaning of the sentence.

*Tip: If, after typing, you think the blank space is too big, reduce the number of spaces you inserted on page 2.

ROLL, WRite, COLOR, & COUNT




