
#### Monday

it eYes, etc.




#### tuesday

#### thursday





#### on your school's copier

I. Print out the pages you need. For example, here are the 4 pages to create the "like" book.



2. Before feeding these pages into the copier, make sure that you have rotated the 2nd and 4th page OPPOSITE from the 1st and 3rd pages- as seen below. Then, insert the stack and print from 1-sided to 2-sided as you normally would.
