Marsha did NOT find anything living in the garden.

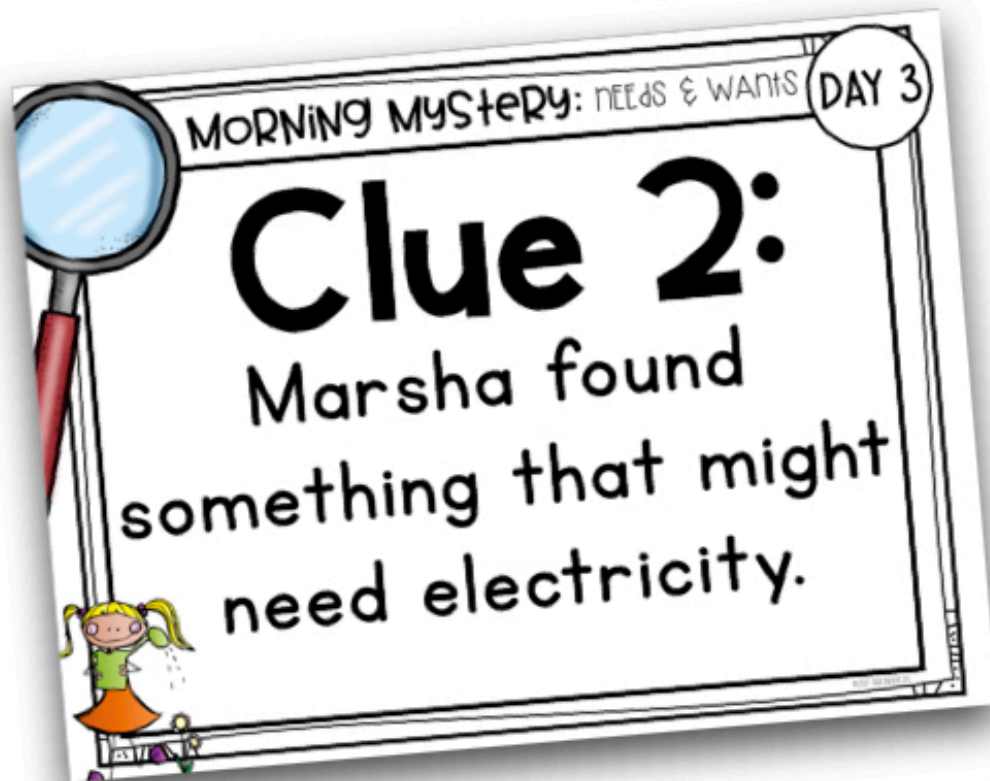

Marsha found something that is small enough to fit in a car.

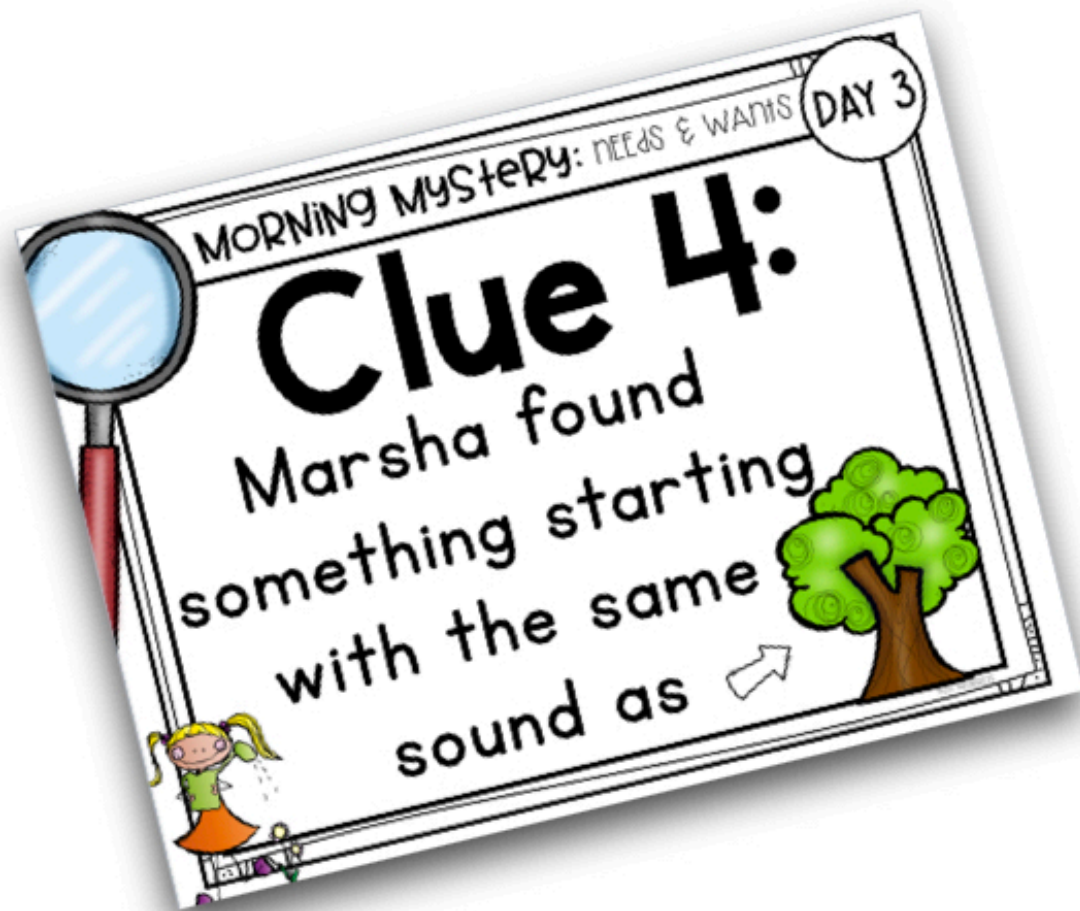
