


Weeks 26-30 EXAMPLE




Each day, students will be given a mystery to solve. In collaboration with each other and with the guidance of their teacher, students will use a set of tools to help them solve each mystery.








*It is even an option to draw the tools and not print ANYTHING.







Students are given 5 CLUES for each mystery. These clues will ask students to use their knowledge of relevant concepts to solve the mystery.







The concepts covered in this pack include:

-counting by 2s






Each mystery fosters collaboration and discussion between peers as students work together to figure out the answer!






Use these mysteries as a brain break, in small group, during morning meeting, as an end-of-day activity, & MORE!


