Marcus did NOT see anything that a bee lives in.

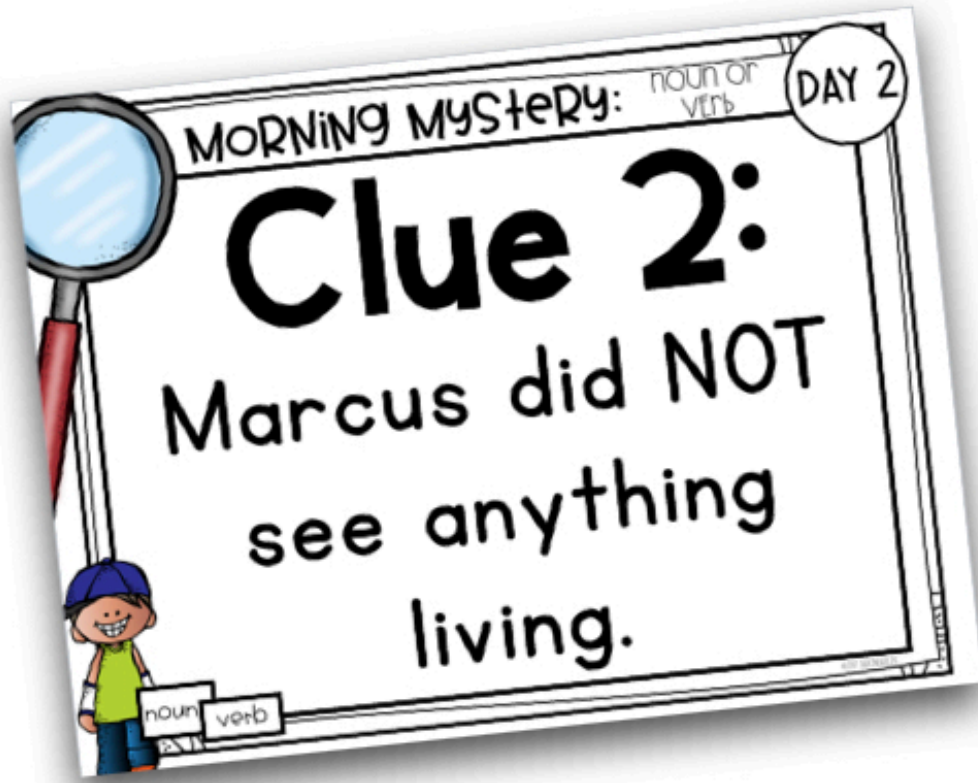


