
#### trash it or collect it

-PARTNER GAME-







Students will need <u>a partner</u>, a dice, and two different colored crayons. Each player will choose one of the colored crayons and write their name in that color at the bottom of the page. Each players rolls and the highest number goes first. Students will take turns rolling the dice and coloring the word associated with that number. Players will try to color 4 sight words to make a row (up, down, or diagonal) to win. If students roll a word that is already <u>all</u> colored, roll again.

#### Roll, Move, ANd Color



 Using the color code, students will color each word accordingly.




