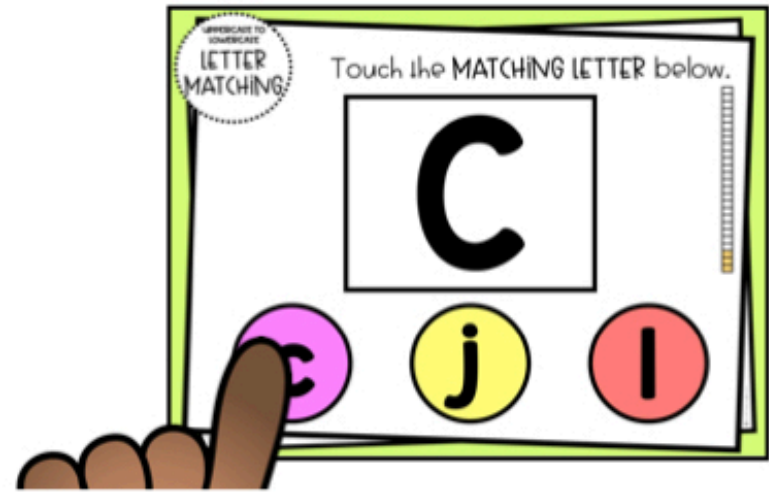

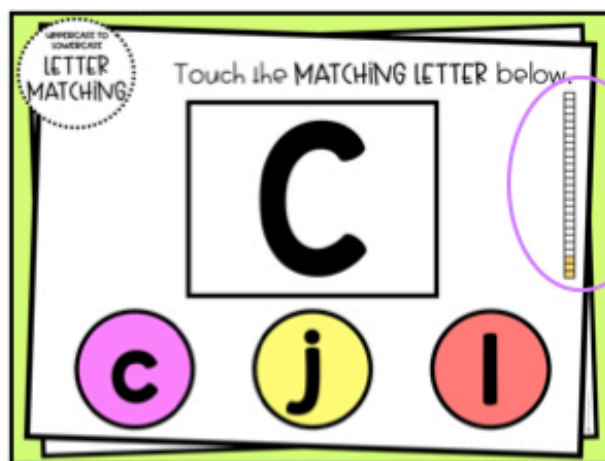
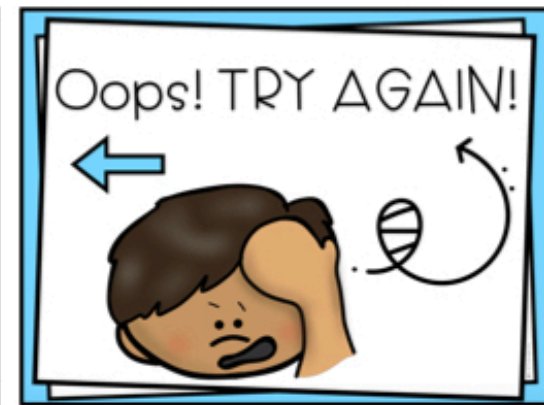

# HOW DO WE PLAY?

-Students will match the uppercase letters to the lowercase letters shown on each slide! If they click the correct letter, they will move to the CORRECT SLIDE. If they click the incorrect letter, they will move to the TRY AGAIN slide.



-Students will click the ARROWS to go back and TRY AGAIN or move forward to the NEXT slide.



-A progress bar is shown to help students know how close they are getting to the end!
