
Students will draw the sight words according to the code. After they are done, they will upload a photo to this page of their finished codes.

- They will type the six sentences in the boxes and drag the blue star to the sentence that matches the picture they drew.





The teacher will prep this page by creating sentences involving the six weekly sight words. These sentences will be opinions, facts, or false statements.









